In partnership with University Neighborhood Partners (UNP), the University of Utah Alumni Association offers annual scholarships to increase access to the completion of higher education endeavors for **Salt Lake City west side students**.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for this University of Utah Alumni Association Scholarship, you must be one of the following:

A Junior or Senior in an undergraduate program at the University of Utah; or A Master's or Doctoral candidate at the University of Utah.

These scholarships are intended for *current or previous west side residents* of Salt Lake City (incorporated). This includes the neighborhoods of Fairpark, Glendale, Jordan Meadows, People's Freeway, Poplar Grove, Rose Park, Ballpark, and Westpointe.

In addition, students are required by state law to certify that they are eligible to receive a scholarship as a U.S. citizen, **OR** are a citizen of another country who is lawfully present in the U.S., **OR** show that they have graduated from a Utah high school.

Please note: these scholarships are very rarely awarded the same person twice.

CONDITIONS

All scholarship recipients must agree to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to receiving a scholarship, documentation must be provided showing acceptance to the University of Utah;
- 2. Each semester, recipients must meet with a Student Success Advocate provided by University Neighborhood Partners; and
- 3. Agree to participate in an exit interview at the end of the academic year.

Scholarship funds will be provided in two installments, deposited directly into the recipient's University of Utah student account at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters.
